The Red Book of C.G. Jung and Its Relevance for Our Time



From 1913 until 1930, Swiss psychoanalyst C. G. Jung entered a vital and difficult period of his life, which he called his “confrontation with the unconscious.” Faced with a flood of mythic figures, fearful visions, and prophetic dreams, he journaled and painted. The resulting *Red Book* was called “the most important book in psychology never published” until its release in 2009.

Jung said: “The years... when I pursued the inner images were the most important time of my life. Everything else is to be derived from this... My entire life consisted in elaborating what had burst forth from the unconscious and flooded me like an enigmatic stream and threatened to break me... the numinous beginning, which contained everything, was then.”

For this presentation, Dr. Malashock will lead us in an exploration of the cultural context as well as the psychological, spiritual, and clinical implications of Jung’s *Red Book*. He will elaborate some of the basic Jungian concepts (derived from the *Red Book*), and explore their use in psychotherapy and personal growth.

Ronald Malashock, Ph.D., is a psychologist, Jungian Analyst, and business and life coach in private practice in San Diego. He received his doctorate from Cornell University and completed his analytic training at the C. G. Jung Institute, Los Angeles. He leads depth-oriented groups called: Dream Destiny Transformation Group and Inward Bound.
