## WAR & RECOVERY



This Friday evening discussion explores programs offering services to returning veterans. Professionals-in-training and practitioners, dealing with a new generation of war vets, receive little training about how to understand and to deal with the physical and psychological ravages of war.

As a small step, four of the nation's foremost experts on veterans' mental health issues will share their experience and wisdom about existing and needed services and support systems.

**Heidi Kraft, PhD**, presents "Rule Number Two: The Challenge of Caring for Combat Trauma." Dr. Kraft is a Former Navy pilot and psychologist, and author of the seminal book *Rule Number Two*. She consults to U.S. Navy and Marine Corps combat stress control programs.

**Jon Nachison, PhD, ABPP**, discusses the *Stand Down* program and the **60 Minutes** feature, "Homeless Veterans: Trying to Find Help and Hope" Jon is a co-founder of the *Stand Down* intervention conceived by veterans for veterans. He is the Chief of Psychology at Bayview and Paradise Valley Hospital.

**Marilyn Cornell, MFT**, presents "Working with Combat Vets in a Residential Treatment Setting." Clinical Director of Veterans Village of San Diego, she has assisted with Stand Down for 23 years. A Marriage and Family therapist, Marilyn is expert on combat stress upon individuals and families.

**CIP Moderator/Discussant: David H. Peterzell, Ph.D., Ph.D.** Veterans Administration San Diego Healthcare System, UCSD & SDSU Psychology. Dr. Peterzell has worked as a psychotherapist and as a researcher of phantom limb pain in veterans with amputations.
